County governments execute their functions using resources transferred from the National Government. Every year, the national and county governments must decide how to share out the revenues collected nationally in order to deliver services to you. This is known as the Division of Revenue process.



To fund the gap between resources that the county will receive from the national government, the county governments is also required to generate their own revenue. This too adds on to the amount of money in a county It is from this share of money, and considering their functions, that the county government will deliver services to you.
